Action Items:

- 1. Come to our members-only meeting Monday, September 15 at 6:00 pm via Zoom. Members will receive a zoom link at their personal email addresses.
- 2. Elect our delegate representatives for the PSEA House of Delegates. The election will run from Monday, 9/8 at 9am until 5pm on Tuesday. Ballots will be sent to personal email addresses on Monday morning; please check spam folders.

Negotiations Updates

Our negotiations team continues to work diligently, both in and outside of formal negotiations meetings, to get us a fair contract. They will attend all-day, face-to-face meetings with administration representatives on September 10th and 11th and hope to make good progress in those discussions. They will update us at our members-only meeting on 9/15 at 6 pm.

Grievance Updates

• The hearing regarding HACC's request to remove our department chairs from the bargaining unit has been rescheduled to November 19, 2025.

- Grievance #25-26-01 (Practicum Pay): A practicum course is being compensated at the "low enrollment" rate, which violates the established status quo. This grievance is proceeding to arbitration (date TBD).
- Grievance #25-26-02 (Course Cancellation): A course with 10 students was cancelled for low enrollment, despite the status quo setting the minimum at 9. This grievance is currently at Step 1 of the Grievance/Arbitration procedure.

<u>Information about our Grievance/Arbitration procedure can be found here</u>. This is in place until a Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) is reached.

Who Do You Call?

Important reminder: according to the terms of our Grievance/Arbitration agreement with the college (see above), bargaining unit members have 10 business days to file a grievance. Should you experience something that you think is a violation of our status quo agreement, reach out to a member of the grievance committee asap. If you're asked to attend a meeting and are concerned about the nature of the meeting (such as potential complaints or disciplinary discussions), please bring a union representative. Our representatives are trained to observe, and their presence in the meetings can be enough to remind administrators of the power of our union.
